- 2. Place nest boxes in the corners of the coop.
- 3. Install a waterer and feeder in the coop.

- Use pressure-treated lumber for all outdoor components of the coop to prevent rot and decay.
- Make sure the coop is well-ventilated to prevent ammonia buildup from chicken waste.
- Provide plenty of perches for the chickens to roost on.
- Clean the coop regularly to keep it clean and healthy for your chickens.

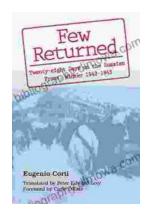
