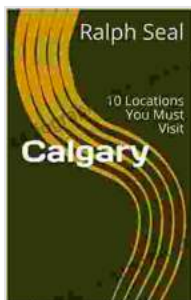

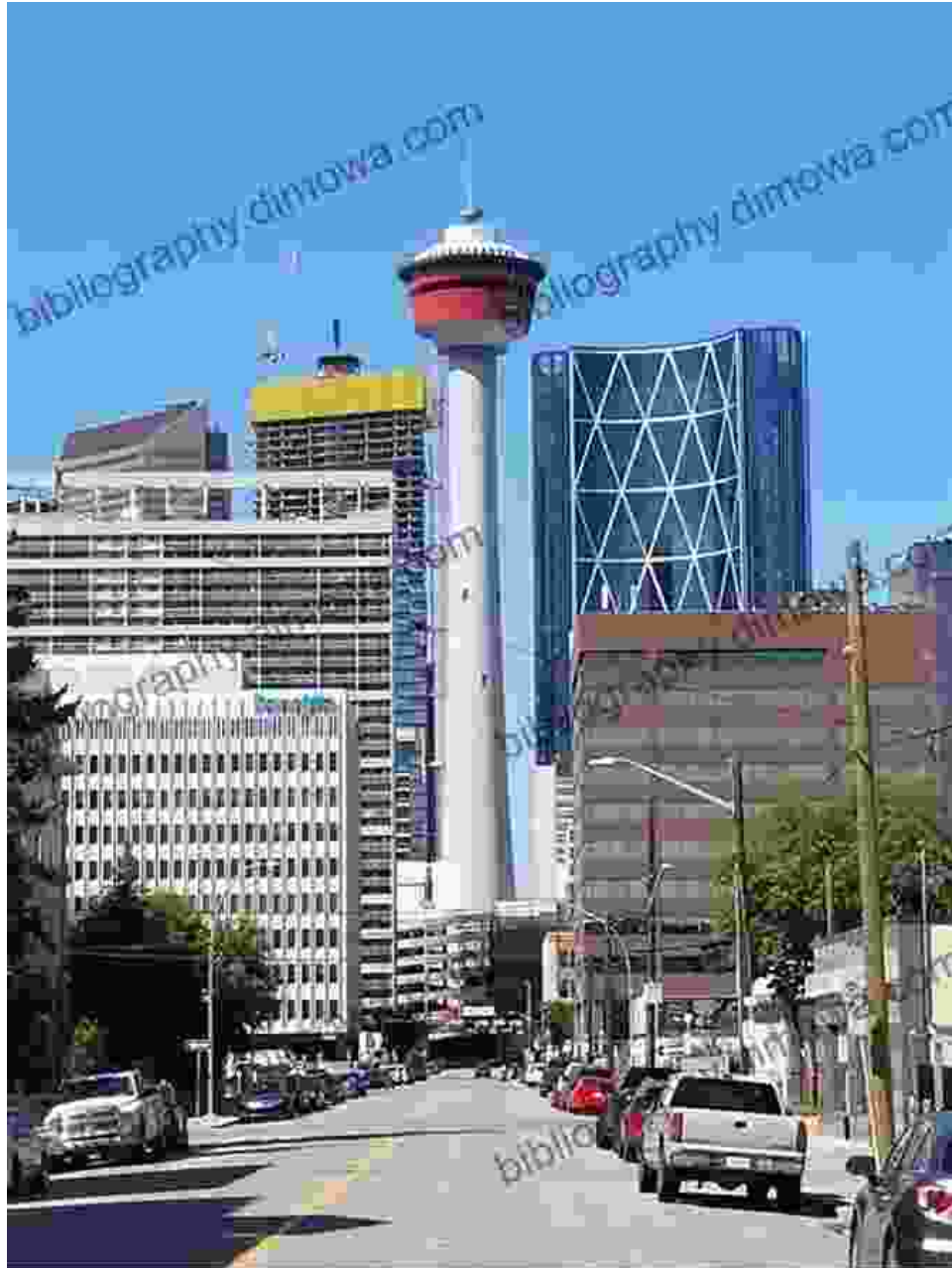

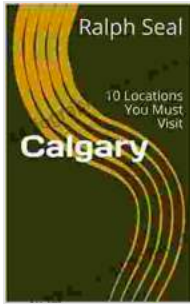


## 9. East Village

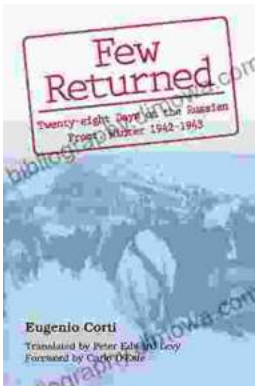

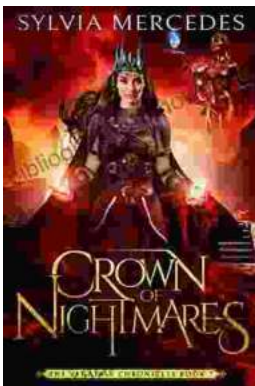
